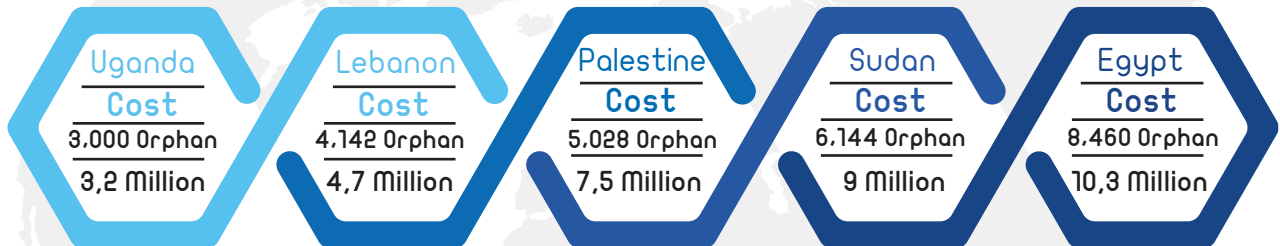

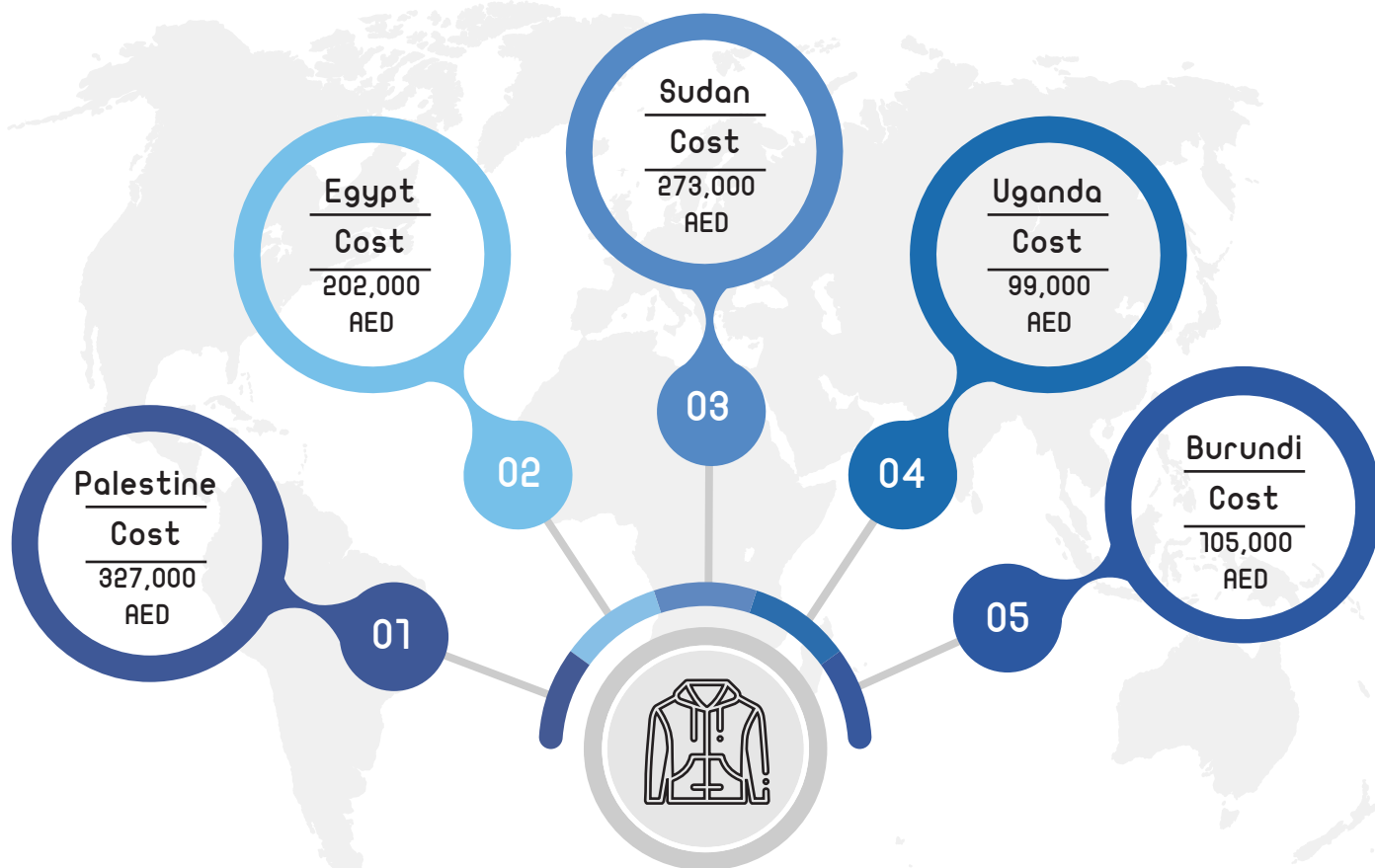

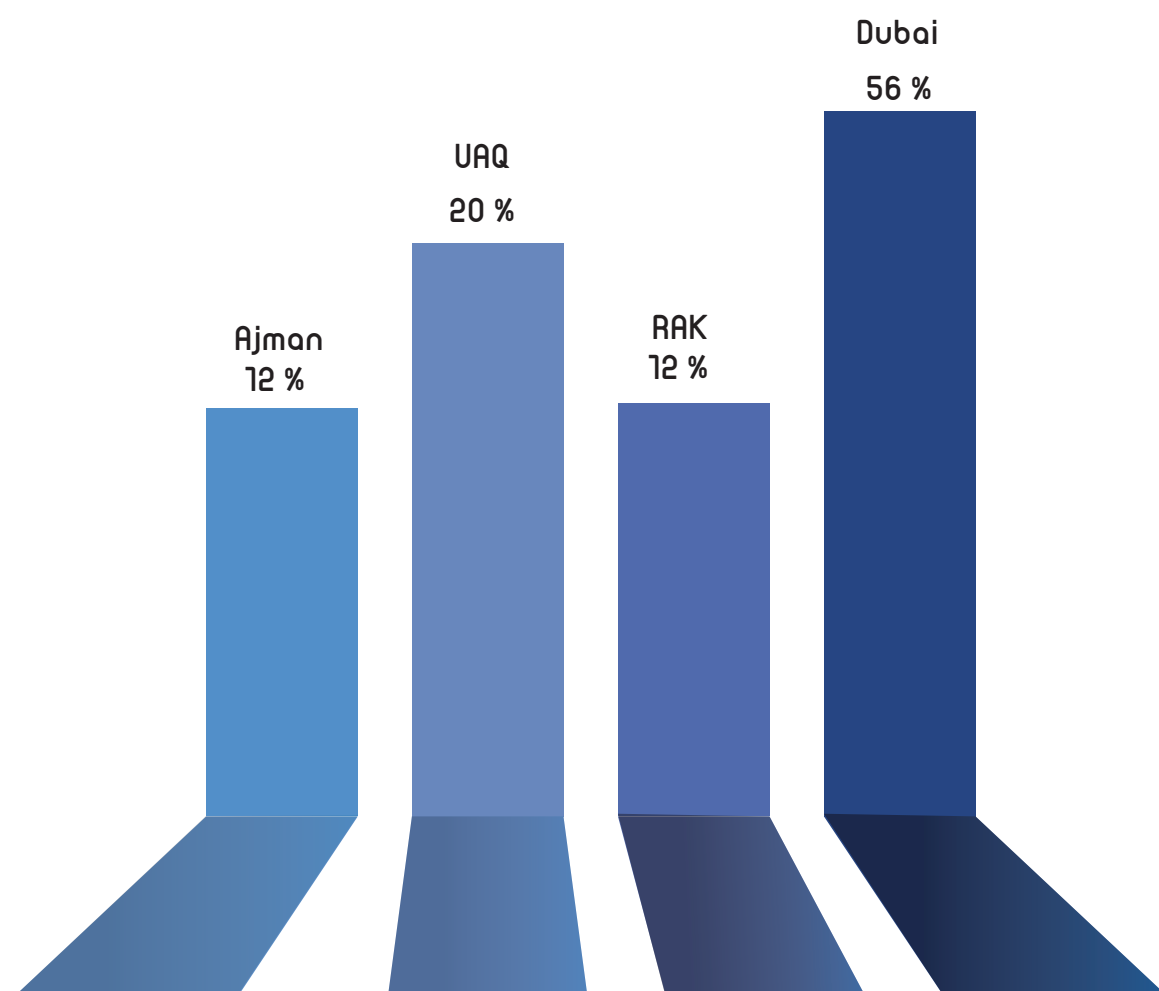

## DAR AL BER AWARD FOR THE HOLY QURAN AND PROPHETIC SUNNAH

It is a cultural award concerned with the service of the Book of Allah "Quran" and the Sunnah of the Prophet "peace and prayers be upon him". It was launched in 1432 AH/2011-AC. The Society has set high goals for the award. The most notably were: memorizing the Book of Allah and the Sunnah of the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him), entrenching it among students and young people, growing the values of the Quran in the awareness and realization of our children, fostering patriotism among them, and supplying the national values which are based on belonging to the homeland and the loyalty to its wise leadership.

The award contains three main branches: the Holy Quran, the Hadith branch and the Islamic jurisprudence (fiqh) branch. Under each branch, there are many levels that suit the age and grade levels of the student.

The award has gained a wide participation in 2018 where the number of the participants in it reached more than 1700 male and female participants. 271 male and female winners won in a total budget of 850,000,00 AED.





## ORPHANS CEREMONY

Dar Al Ber Society celebrated the 13th consecutive annual ceremony for orphans, which was first launched in 2006. The 13th annual ceremony for orphans was held under the patronage of the wife of His Highness Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Her Highness Sheikha Hind bint Maktoum bin Juma Al Maktoum May God protect and care her, on Friday 2018/05/25 in the presence of Sheikh Hamad bin Mohammed bin Hamad Al Sharqi, Sheikh Mohammed bin Maktoum bin Juma Al Maktoum, the sponsors of the ceremony and a number of community figures.

The ceremony was attended by 200 orphans from UAE and 23 orphans from outside UAE, where tickets were provided to them and their companions and they were hosted in a hotel for ten days. Also, a touristic program was organized for them in the country, including some of the landmarks of the UAE such as Dubai Museum, Dubai Metro, Dubai Frame, Sheikh Zayed Mosque Abu Dhabi, Louvre Abu Dhabi, Dubai Creek Cruise, LEGOLAND Dubai, Ski Dubai, Butterfly Garden, KidZania, Aquarium, and Burj Khalifa. The countries that had orphans in the ceremony of Dar Al Ber Society were: Senegal, Mali, Ghana, Egypt, Sudan, Lebanon, Mauritania, Ivory Coast, Uganda, Niger, and Tanzania.
